



Position Overview

The board of directors is the legal authority for the organization; each director is responsible for understanding the mission, visions values, program goals and fiscal responsibilities of the Latino Chamber of Commerce.

Board of Director Roles and Responsibilities

1. Board terms are 2 years. Dues: \$100/annually
2. Accountable to the Chamber Board of Directors.
3. Attends board meetings and important related meetings on a regular basis.
The Full Board of Directors meets the 4th Tuesday of every month at 5:30pm – 7:30pm at the Chamber Office. The Executive Team meets the 3rd Tuesday of every month at 6:00 – 7:30pm at the Chamber Office
4. Board Members are expected to serve on at least one Chamber committee: Fundraising, Marketing, Membership, or Events
5. Volunteers for and willingly accepts assignments and completes them thoroughly and on time.
6. Stays informed about committee matters, prepares themselves well for meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports.
7. Builds a collegial working relationship with other committee members that contribute to consensus.
8. Participates in the committee's annual evaluation and planning efforts.
9. Participates in membership recruitment for the organization.
10. Board members are expected to participate in any fundraising events organized the organization in order to procure revenues or resources to cover the organization operating expenses.
11. Enhance the Chamber's Public Image
